Here are some easy water saving tips!

- ✓ **Wash clothes only when you have a full load.**
- ✓ **Turn the faucet off when brushing teeth or shaving.**
- ✓ **Avoid flushing the toilet unnecessarily.**
- ✓ **Dispose of tissues and other waste in the trash can instead of the toilet.**

- ✓ **Repair leaks in toilet or faucet RIGHT AWAY.**
- ✓ **Put aerators on faucets to reduce flow.**
- ✓ **Defrost frozen food overnight in refrigerator instead of running water over it.**
- ✓ **Avoid letting water run continuously in sink while washing dishes.**

- ✓ **Water your lawn only once a week.**
- ✓ **Use a broom or a blower to remove dirt and debris from patios.**
- ✓ **Use a shut-off nozzle on your hose.**
- ✓ **Plant drought tolerant grasses, ground covers, shrubs and trees.**

Here are some easy water saving tips!

- ✓ **Consider using a commercial car wash that recycles water. If you wash your own car, park on the grass and use a hose with an automatic shut-off nozzle.**
- ✓ **Raise the lawn mower blade to at least three inches, or to its highest level. A higher cut encourages grass roots to grow deeper, shades the root system and holds soil moisture.**

Here are some easy water saving tips!

- ✓ **Use mulch to retain moisture in the soil. (Help preserve native cypress forests by selecting other types of mulch such as treated melaleuca.) Mulch also helps control weeds that compete with landscape plants for water.**
- ✓ **Water lawns during the early morning hours when temperatures and wind speed are the lowest. This reduces evaporation and waste.**
