

# Proposed Changes to FPUA Rates

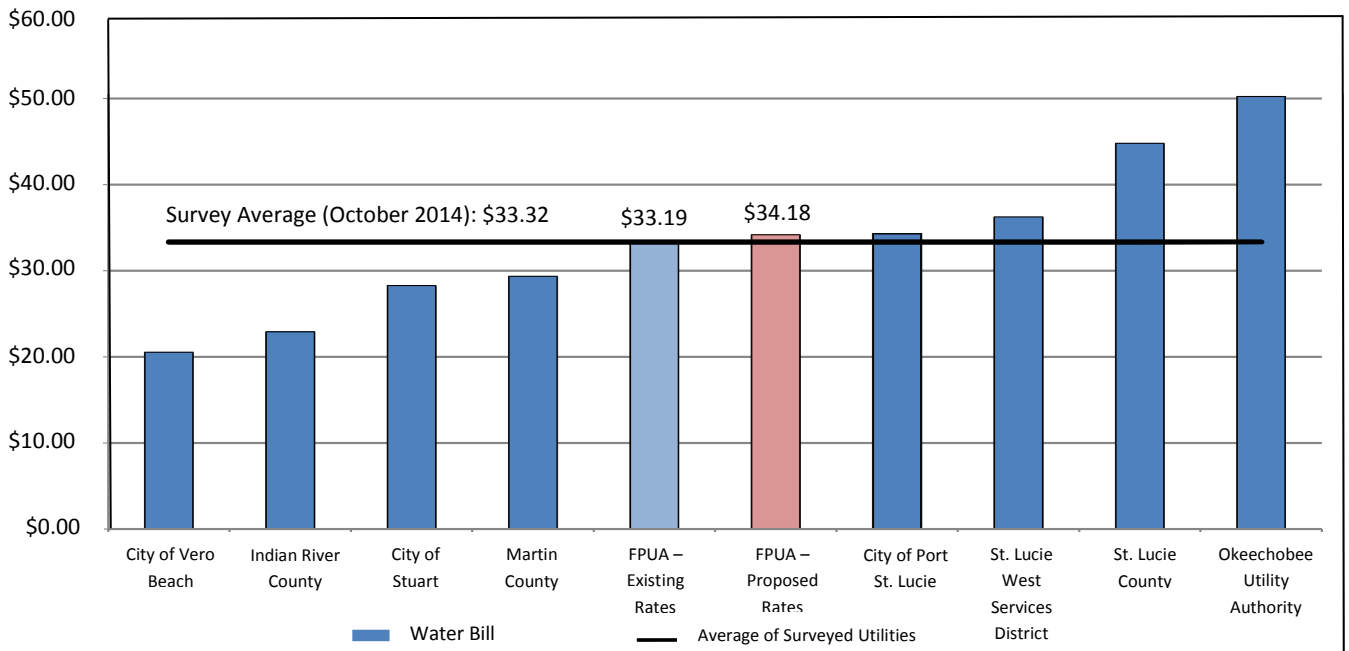
On February 3, 2015 - Fort Pierce Utilities Authority (FPUA) Board will hold a public hearing to discuss proposed changes to water utility rates. The meeting will be held at 6:00 PM in the City Commission Chambers, 100 North U.S. 1, Fort Pierce, Florida. If FPUA's Board approves the changes, the next public meeting will be the Fort Pierce City Commission meeting on February 17, 2015 at 6:30 PM, also to be held in the City Commission Chambers.

Based on average monthly residential usage, the proposed rate change is as follows:

**Water:** increase \$0.99 for 6,000 gallons

**Why is FPUA proposing rate changes?** As a result of cost cuts implemented by FPUA over the past four years, the electric, gas and wastewater utility are generating adequate revenue, but the water utility is still deficient. The proposed rate change is directed toward making the water utility self-sufficient.
