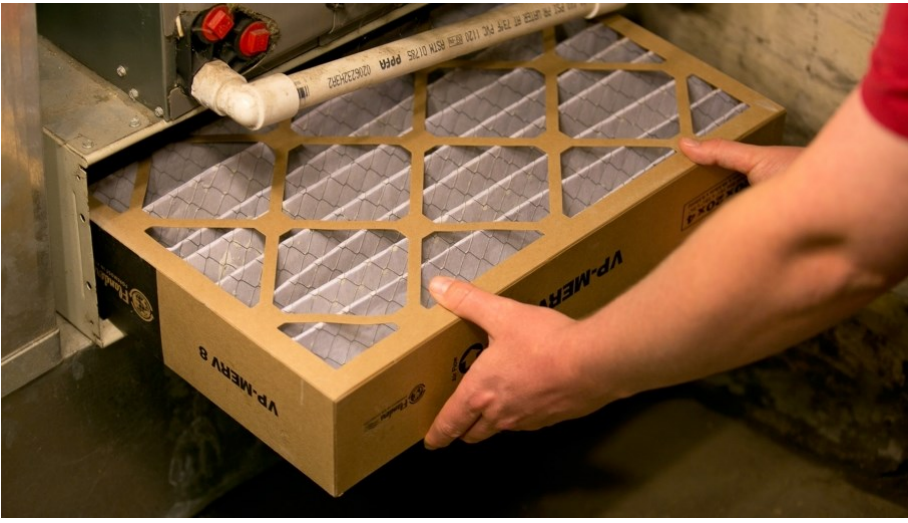


How Often Should You Have a Furnace Inspection?
